ABSTRACTS REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Typing editor Microsoft Word 6.0, 7.0: font Times New Roman; size 12; line spacing 1,0; size: paragraph 10 mm; page margins 2.0 cm.
- 2. The file name must match to the name of the author (or first co-author). The file is stored in .doc, .docx, or .rtf format (eg, Shevchenko.doc).
- 3. The recommended volume of abstracts up to 3 pages. Pagination not affixed, transfers in the text are not allowed.
- 4. At the right side print the name of the author(s), and in footnote provides scientific degree, title, position, place of work and email. In the middle of the sheet print the title of abstracts in capital letters (12, bold) and annotation on one of the conference languages.
- 5. The text of the report must contain next structural elements: relevance, problem statement, a statement of research results, conclusions, list of references. <u>Structural elements of the text are not stand out!</u>
- 6. Figures and tables must be made by means of Microsoft Word or Microsoft Excel using black and white color and placed in the text, preserving the possibility of editing. Scanned tables and figures from other books are not allowed. All tables and figures should be named using the font Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold and presented in a portrait page. Sequential numbering of figures and tables in Arabic numerals (Fig. 1, Tab. 1), and references in the text are required. Formulas placed in the center, numbered in parenthesis right-side. When typing formulas use the formula editor Microsoft Equation, built in Microsoft Word.
- 7. References, issued the text in square brackets. The first number is the number of sources from the bibliography, the second is the page number. Numbers of sources and page numbers are separated by a comma, between the two numbers of sources the point of coma, for example: [1, p 95-96], [2; 5; 7].
- 8. After the text of the abstracts by one paragraph specify a list of references (in alphabetical order). Heading for the list "Literature" (font size 12, bold italic). Bibliographic description of the sources of abstracts in Russian and Ukrainian is issued in accordance with GOST 7.1-2006 (recommended service http://vak.in.ua), and for the abstracts in English in accordance with international bibliographic standards APA (http://www.bibme.org/citation-guide/APA/book).
